



Kindergarten School Supply List

Please write your name on all personal and clothing items using a black sharpie. Some of these items will need to be replenished during the year.

- 1 Kindermat (example Walmart- Peerless Plastic Red/Blue size 19x45)
- 1 Regular sized Backpack (No rolling bookbags or luggage permitted)
- 1 Lunchbox for lunch labeled with child's name
- 1 Snack container or brown bag/Ziploc bag labeled with child's name
- 1 Refillable water container with straw, or send in daily water bottle for snack
- 1- 5" Fiskars Blunt Scissors
- 4 Large Glue Sticks
- 1 Package of Low Odor Dry Erase Markers (4 – 5 count)
- 3 Packages of #2 pencils – pre-sharpened
- 2 Boxes of 24 count Crayons
- 2 Red or Green Plastic Pocket Folders (no prongs)
- 3 Blue, Yellow, or Orange Paper Pocket Folders (no prongs)
- 3 Packages of white copy/printer paper
- Colored Tissue Paper
- 1 Set of Crayola Watercolor Paints
- 1 Package of Hand Wipes or Baby Wipes
- 1 Package of Modeling Clay
- 1 Primary Composition Notebook with Picture Space
blank space at top of page for drawing pictures and lines below for writing
- Earbuds or Headphones (put in Ziploc bag labeled with name)
- Change of clothes in Ziploc bag – kept in backpack at all times
(ICS Dress uniform or ICS PE uniform with underpants & socks)

Cleaning Supplies

- 2 Large Rolls of Paper Towels
- 1 Container of Disinfecting Wipes – no bleach
- 1 Unscented Baby Wipes or Wet Wipes
- 1 box of Ziploc Lunch Size bags
- Girls 1 box of Ziploc Quart Size bags
- Boys 1 box of Ziploc Gallon Size bags
- 2 box of Band-aids
- 1 bottle of Germ X

Spanish Class

Class Uniforms:

**Please note, Kindergarten students must have two uniforms. One for everyday wear and one for P.E. days.

Boys Daily/Formal Uniform:

- School logo hunter green short-sleeved polo tucked in so belt can be seen
- Navy blue uniform pants or uniform shorts worn at the waistline
- Black or navy plain belt (except Kindergarten)
- Socks may be white or black, any length as long as the sock is visible above the shoe and without logos
- All black shoes with black soles; no lights or wheels, no logos unless they are all black
- Navy blue or hunter green school logo sweatshirt for cold weather. Sweatshirts worn throughout the school day must be school issued

Girls Daily/Formal Uniform:

- School logo plaid jumper with hunter green polo and bike/tumbler shorts underneath
- School logo hunter green uniform polo shirt tucked in
- Navy blue uniform pants, shorts, or plaid skorts. Shorts and skorts must be within 2 inches of the knee. Pants, skorts and shorts must be sized appropriately and not tight-fitting.
- Socks may be white or black, any length as long as the sock is visible above the shoe and without logos. White or navy tights may be worn in cooler weather
- All black shoes with black soles; no lights or wheels, no logos unless they are all black
- Navy blue or hunter green school logo sweatshirt for cold weather. Sweatshirts worn throughout the school day must be school issued

Boys and Girls PE Uniforms:

Students should wear the PE uniform on any day they are scheduled to have PE class. Students should wear the PE uniform even if the school will attend Mass.

- School logo navy blue PE Shirt
- Gray mesh uniform shorts; please make sure that shorts fit properly since students will be required to purchase new ones if they do not fit properly; students who are consistently not dressed in the PE uniform will receive a drop in the PE grade
- Socks may be white or black, any length as long as the sock is visible above the shoe and without logos.
- All black shoes with black soles; no lights or wheels, no logos unless they are all black (can be daily shoes)
- Plain gray or navy sweatpants during cold weather. Leggings are not permitted, for all grades, as a replacement to sweatpants
- Navy blue or hunter green school logo sweatshirt for cold weather. Sweatshirts worn throughout the school day must be school issued
